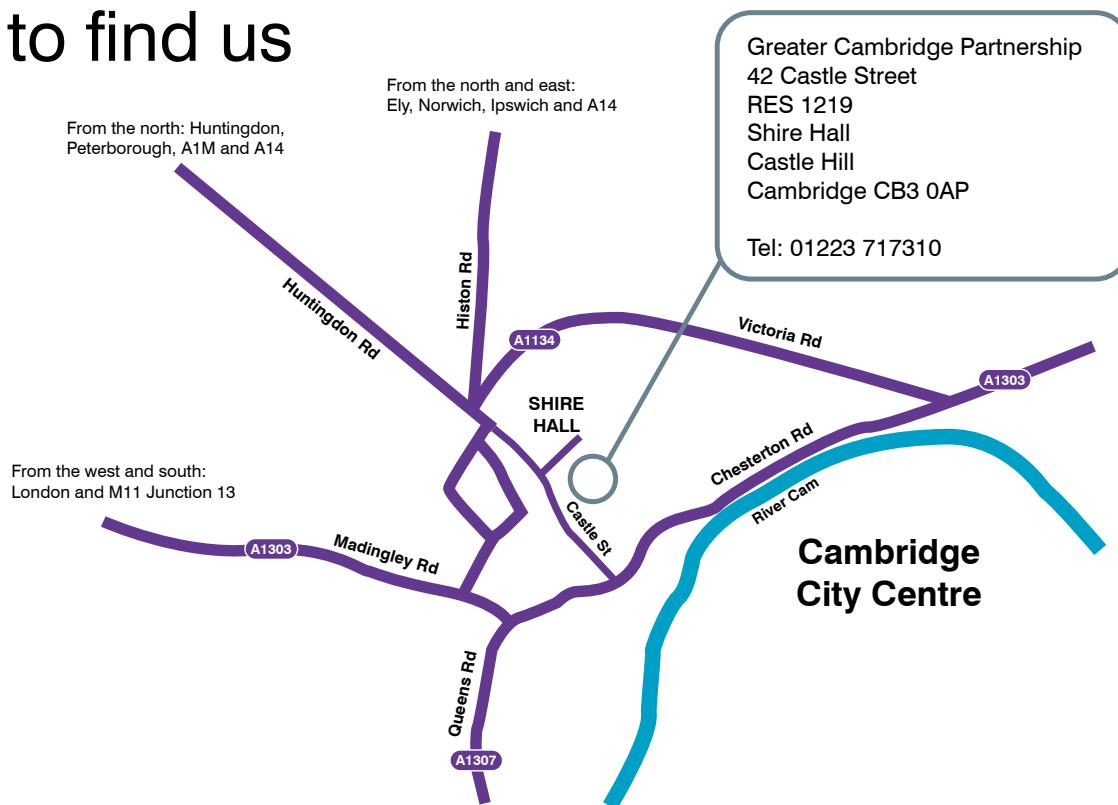


# How to find us



## By road

If you are travelling by car, a detailed route planner can be obtained from the AA website. There is limited visitor car parking available onsite, and a pay and display car park nearby.

### From the North-West

The A14 from the north feeds into the A1307 (Huntingdon Road). Continue along Huntingdon Road until a main set of traffic lights. Continue straight on through the traffic lights onto Castle Street. The entrance for the public pay and display car park is the first turning on the left. The entrance for Shire Hall is the third on the left.

### From the North

Travelling along the A10 south join the A14 heading west, from Milton roundabout (following signs for Huntingdon). Exit at the next junction and take the first left onto the B1049 (Histon Road) travelling south. At the end of Histon Road, turn right onto Victoria Road then immediately left onto Castle Street. The entrance for the public pay and display car park is the first turning on the left. The entrance for Shire Hall is the third on the left.

### From the East

Travelling on the A14, exit onto the B1049 (Histon Road) travelling south. At the end of Histon Road, turn right onto Victoria Road then immediately left onto Castle Street. The entrance for the public pay and display car park is the first turning on the left. The entrance for Shire Hall is the third on the left.

### From the South

From the south exit the M11 at Junction 13 and travel east on the A1303 (Madingley Road). For Park & Ride, follows signs along Madingley Road. At the end of Madingley Road (a mini-roundabout) take the first exit left onto Northampton Street. At the crossroad junction, turn left onto Castle Street. The entrance for the public pay and display car park is the third turning on the right. The entrance for Shire Hall is the first on the right.

### From the West

Travelling on the A428 (St Neots Road) from the west, follow signs for the A1303. Continue along the A1303 across the M11 onto Madingley Road. For Park & Ride, follows signs along Madingley Road. At the end of Madingley Road (a mini-roundabout) take the first exit left onto Northampton Street. At the crossroad junction, turn left onto Castle Street. The entrance for the public pay and display car park is the third turning on the right. The entrance for Shire Hall is the first on the right.

## By rail

There are direct rail links between Cambridge and London Liverpool Street and London King's Cross. It takes less than one hour to travel by train to the capital, with mainland Europe accessible by Eurostar from London Waterloo. Rail, road and bus links provide easy access from Cambridge to the surrounding market towns.
